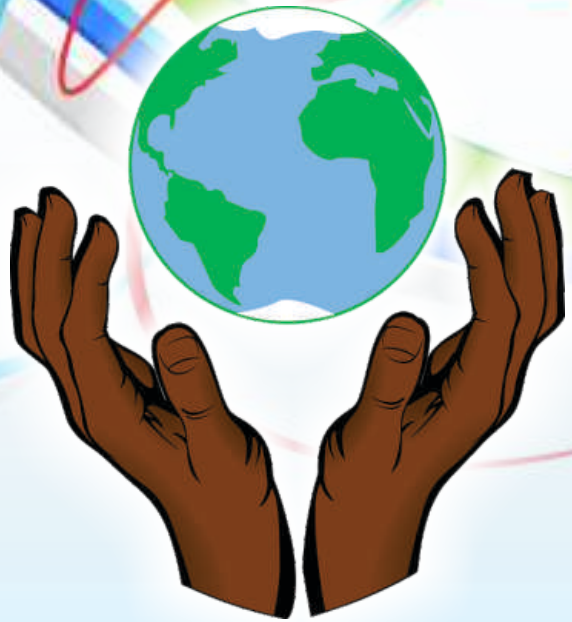

NON FORMAL EDUCATION

Project *Light of Wisdom* began in 2013 as a response to the apparent requirement for a quality education programme to educate the disadvantaged and out of school dropout children in India.

Under project light of wisdom, care India welfare trust has provided education to more than 13000 children so far.

Education is light to darkness, source of happiness, power to the weak, words for the dumb, music to the deaf, dream of the blind. Education is the only solution to almost

every problem of today's life. But unfortunately in India, we still have uneducated people. For some unveiled reasons, they are deprived from the light of education. Knowing the fact, how necessary it is to educate the girls in our country. Despite this fact since ages, females in our nation have been suffering from various discriminations (for example, dowry pratha, domestic violence etc). Somehow they have not been able to have upper hand in their lives & decisions due to lack of knowledge. Therefore we started our program and associated trained faculty with us to educate girl child.



Children's Tutorial Center: Our Young Urns receive academic support after school. In these classes basic concepts of Mathematics, Science and other subjects are taught, to bridge the gaps in learning and enable children to attain grade-specific competency levels.

We also provides bridge courses to those children who have suffered breaks in their formal education. The program provides intensive coaching to such children, aiming to help them rejoin formal schooling in a class relevant to their ages groups.

We take care of their educational requirements,

providing not only academic support that enables them to define success of their schooling experience but also material support.

This includes uniforms, books, school bags, shoes, socks and other stationary requirements etc. to enable the girl child to go to school with dignity. The material kit is ceremoniously handed over to each child at the beginning of the academic year.

The program selects children based on multiple criteria, viz low family income, guardian's educational background, social background and the child's aptitude.

A basic principle of the Project is to enable kids to relate textbook learning with everyday life. Study tours and outings are arranged regularly which enables them to make these connections. Apart from the educational inputs, outings bring a sense of adventure and fun into learnings. This makes educational tours an integral part of Project. One Educational tour is organized every six months.

We conducted the first trip in aug 2014 .since then ,in these trips we take kids to different fairs,museam & planetariums etc twice a year.

So CIWT tried to revive this Beautiful tradition of poetry amongst these kids.

HEALTH CAMP

Many Health Camp were organised in West Delhi, Rohini and South Delhi and 4 major camps were organised and more than 30,000 beneficiaries got benefitted. Proper health care regime was suggested to them to prevent any preventable diseases in future. Due to low Social-Economic status and inadequate access to health care, poor people remain uncured of diseases like chronic fevers, jaundice, tuberculosis, heart diseases etc.

Care India Welfare Trust implements health care camp under the umbrella of its health care initiatives.

More than 30000 beneficiaries directly benefitted from this program.

EAT HEALTHY AND BE HEALTHY

As food is important for both physical and mental well being, the importance of food in life is huge. Proper nutrition aims to get all the essential nutrients required for healthy functioning of the body through your diet. These nutrients include vitamins and minerals, fats, carbohydrates, and proteins.

Good nutrition is an important part of leading a healthy lifestyle. Combined with physical activity, our diet can help us to reach and maintain a healthy body, reduce risk of chronic diseases (like heart disease and cancer), and promotes overall health, CIWT team in west and south Delhi held various group discussions and organised FGD for proper intake of nutrition. Around 24 such sessions were held with the help of GRCs NGOs in Uttam Nagar, Kirti Nagar, Bhajanpura. & Rohini Jain Nagar.

There were 6-7 Health Awareness sessions held for better **HEALTH CARE BY WOMEN AT HOME** and a few Health Camps were organised at various locations around Delhi about specific calcium intakes to keep bones strong. There were special sessions conducted on 100% RDA of Calcium, tips for stronger bones, importance of Bone Health, A general Health care for Teenagers, middle aged and Old Aged were organised at various outlets which include Women's Health Care, quality obstetrical and gynecological care with the warmth, responsiveness and accessibility of clinic in need.

Puberty awareness camps were organised and women were educated about importance of menstrual hygiene. Sanitary napkins were distributed and a gynecological session was organised for women in slums.

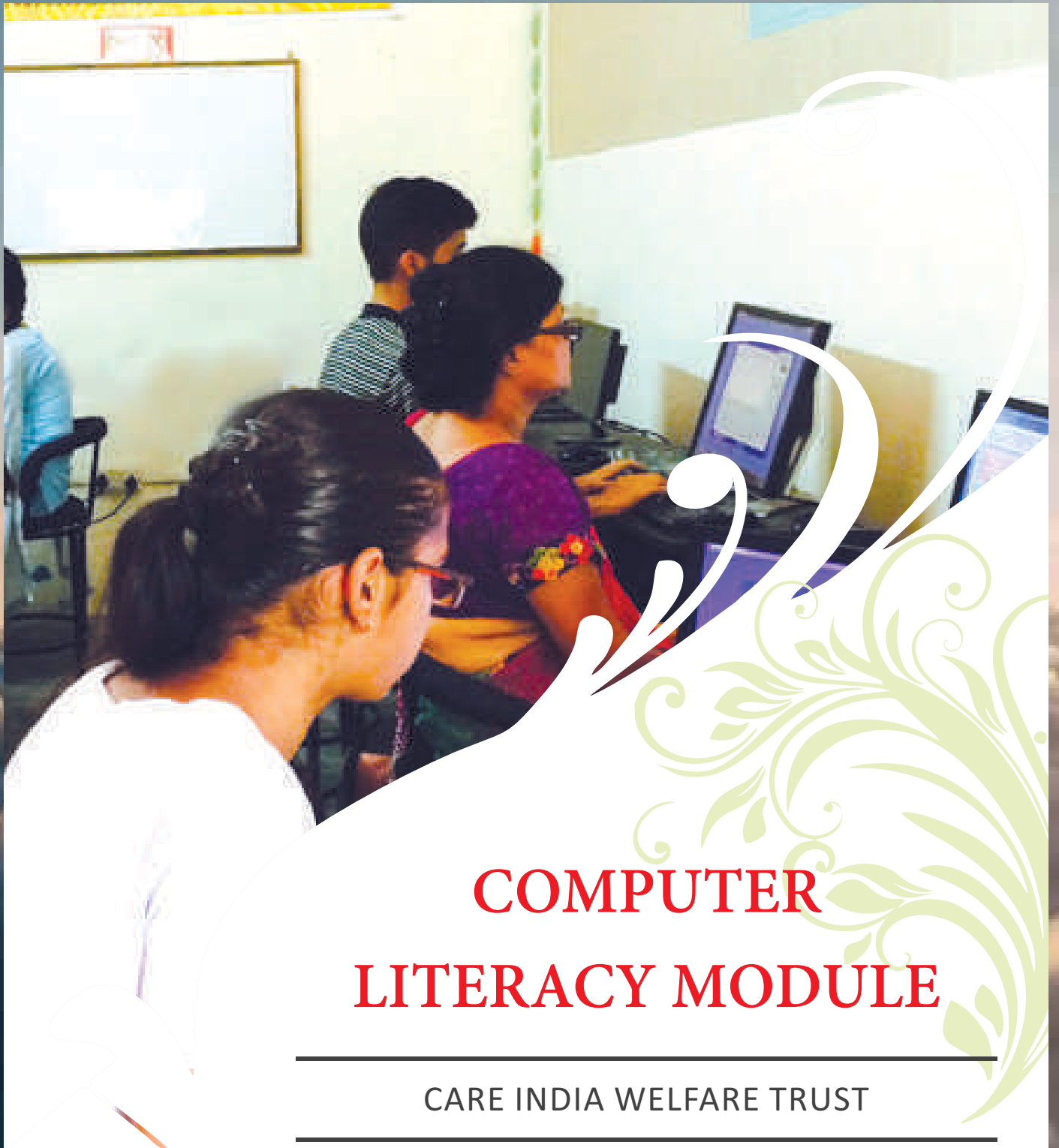

Inauguration of Vocational center for under privileged children took place at Chuna Bhatti on 24th-Dec-2016 by Shri Satyendra Jain Honourable Minister of Health, Delhi Government and witnessed over 20 delegates belonging to NGO's, Corporates and Research Institutions.



COMPUTER LITERACY MODULE

CARE INDIA WELFARE TRUST

According to a recent study conducted by the Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India (ASSOCHAM), there will be a deficit of 40 million working professionals by the year 2020 and about 41% of the employers are faced with the difficulty of filling positions because of the dearth of suitable talent and skill in their industry. At this juncture CIWT opened up Computer training Programme at Rohini and Kirti Nagar Center.

COMPUTER LITERACY MODULE

CARE INDIA WELFARE TRUST



Our goal is to provide vocational and job oriented training to the under privileged children and girls. When a girl return home with the ability to stand on her own feet, it does more to improve the perception of the girl child in her neighborhood and also inspires other girls and women to make something of themselves creating such examples of skillful girl is a better way to inspire, in spite of million pamphlets and dozens of talks! They gained skills and confidence through our computer training program to attain successful placements. In Delhi, there are many BPO's where young people come everyday to earn their bread and butter! These BPO's can be a good source of generating employment.

Computer literacy is the knowledge and ability to use computers and technology efficiently. The precise approach of CIWT lies in making youth and children skilled in computer literacy through six months computer course which is based on government guidelines and meets all professional requirements. As computer literacy is considered a very important skill to possess to enable this we procured 85 computer units with experience trainer.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS & PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT

SPOKEN ENGLISH & BPO TRAINING



Language is essentially a means of communication among the members of a society. In the expression of culture, language is a fundamental aspect. It is the tool that conveys traditions and values related to group identity and Spoken English has become essential for each one whether remain to be a salary holder or Entrepreneur. Therefore many volunteer, faculty from MNCs / Govt Organisation got associated with CIWT team to add the essence of spoken english and touch up of body language. More than 1000 girls ,boys and middle aged became learner and now ahead in their life.

The training was comprehensive and included all necessary topics in the mentioned subjects. After sewing training, women became productive to sew clothes for themselves and their families. Others managed to sew clothes for their neighborhood as well.

After successfully completing the

training, We provide sewing machine and material as a grant which will help them to start a small business.

By strengthening women we are actually strengthening roots to a better society. So we tailor made this project, in this we are providing sewing (cutting-tailoring) classes to women of slums and poor areas. We provide them practice material as well. It also help them earn additional income to earn sustainable livelihood for them & their families. We have distributed 5 sewing machines to the neediest candidates as well.

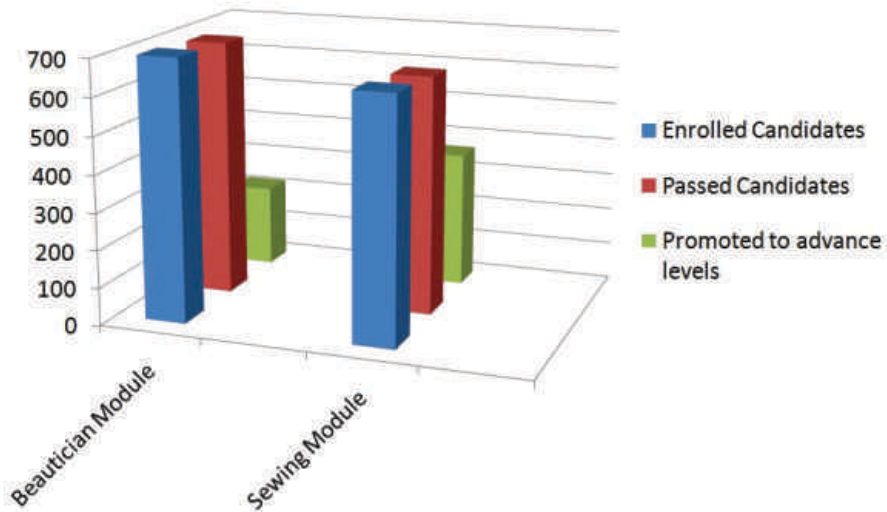

FOOD DISTRIBUTION CAMPS

CIWT always aims at not only one too days of supports by providing food, but also encourages them to eat healthy, cook healthy & stay healthy in long sum. Such camps are organised by CIWT on regular intervals in various areas around Delhi.

LEGAL AWARENESS PROJECT

CARE INDIA WELFARE TRUST



Legal Aid means giving free legal services to the poor and needy who are unable to afford the services of an advocate for the conduct of a case or a legal proceeding in any court, tribunal or before an Judicial authority CIWT organised various legal awareness programmes and held quizzes on various Acts namely Domestic Violence Act-2005, Acts on Stalking, The Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and regulation of Trade and Commerce, production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003, Harassment at Workplace Acts, Criminal Amendment Acts-2013. Around 36 Awareness sessions were organised in West Delhi, East Delhi, North Delhi and South Delhi and more than 1500 slum dwellers participated and many of them are enrolled for further assistance.

BETI PADHAO –BETI BADHAO (A CAMPAIGN TO EDUCATE AND ENCOURAGE GIRLS)

The project was implemented with a vision to support poor girl students for their schooling in 2013 with 50 girls and still counting from the area of West Delhi & South Delhi.

The CIWT team has been providing them monthly allowance for their tuition fee.

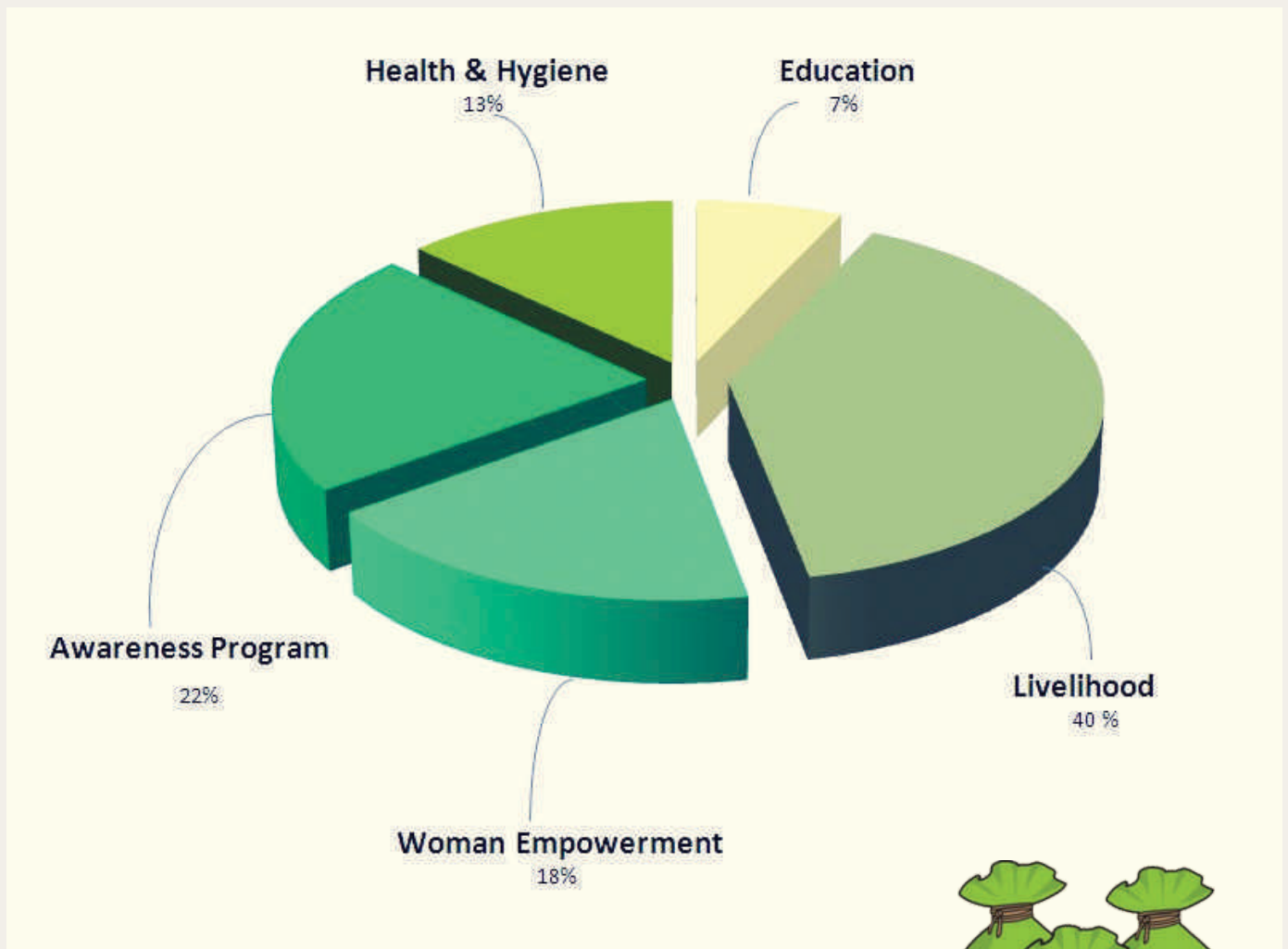
